Remember to look only in Andover City Parks Please keep things clean and don't look past dark.</p> <p>Aurora Borealis visited Andover this year It sure was quite a sight! Take a cue from the great display, To get the location right</p>	<p>Northern Lights - gives a hint the word North is in the park name</p>

Count the cost Chase the clues Criss cross the city Courses you choose</p> <p>Take shelter while you ponder And one to note while you wander Let's play ball, take your base, Time to figure out the place!</p>	<p>Dominance of C words - the park is in the "C" section of the City Parks map</p> <p>The park amenities include a picnic shelter, "and one" points to a basketball court, and take your base confirms there is also a baseball field. You can narrow down the parks using the grid on the city park map</p>
<p>3. High on a hill, tucked in a tree? Container for gum, Nestled under some brush maybe?</p> <p>History repeats itself? Could be bittersweet if true, New places are best when reading this clue.</p>	<p>Listing previous year hiding spots</p> <p>Asking if a previous park is used again this year. Bittersweet is a nearby street name Confirms it is NOT hidden in a previous park *Main clue is the HCN HCN pattern of the first letter of each line: Hidden Creek North</p>
<p>4. Concealed but not buried Like a stream in December Part of our state's name if we rightly remember</p>	<p>Concealed = Hidden Stream = Creek Part of State's Name (L'Etoile du Nord) = North</p>
<p>5. Time to play like a kid again Off to the playground we go! Find it while playing, Thomas can help The winner will have to bend low!</p>	<p>Look on the playground Thomas = Thomas the Train - the train spring-rider; look underneath it</p>
